

2018-19 Dow High Music Boosters Fruit Sale Information



Why are we selling?

- This is the PRIMARY FUNDRAISER for DHS Music!
- Music Directors rely on this sale to support and manage your DHS Choirs, Orchestras, and Bands.

What are we selling?

- **Navel Oranges** for \$26/case (about 40 fruit) or \$13/half case
- **Grapefruit** for \$24/case (about 20 fruit) or \$12/half case

Student Goal:

- **10 points** is your goal, with at least 5 points coming from fruit sales or donations
- Earn one point for each *case* sold
- Earn one point for each \$10 in *cash donations* collected
- Earn one point for each *hour* you volunteer outside of selling

How should orders be turned in?

- Clip checks or cash to EACH individual customer's order
- Band all your orders together to turn in to your captain

When should orders be turned in?

- Turn in orders and payments to your team captain during music class on these tally days:

Friday, December 14

Friday, January 4

Wednesday, January 9

When does fruit arrive?

- On Thursday, January 31st, the quality premium fruit is delivered to Dow High, *fresh* from the orchards in Florida, Texas, and California

How is fruit unloaded?

- Students unload, inspect, and package fruit into separate orders during their music class times on January 31st. **Dress warmly!**

When do customers pick up their orders?

- Thursday, January 31st from 4 pm to 7 pm
- Friday, February 1st from 4 pm to 7 pm OR
- Saturday, February 2nd, from 9 am to 3 pm

Where and how do customers pick up their orders?

- Customers drive right up to the music rooms at Dow High - enter the Dow High Parking lot via the traffic light at N. Saginaw & Perrine Rd and just follow the signs
- Students and volunteers load customer orders into their cars. **(Dress warmly when you come to volunteer that weekend!)**
- Students also pick up fruit they (or their family) are delivering personally to their customers ***on these days***
